- *Friendships - Give today's teenagers wisdom in choosing their friends. Bring people into their lives who will point them to Christ. 1 Corinthians 15:33, Hebrews 10:25, 1 Thessalonians 5:11, 1 Samuel 16:7*
- *Character - That this generation of students may experience an ongoing transformation by having their minds renewed with the Word of God. That they will be examples to the world in their speech, lives, love, faith, and purity. 1 Timothy 4:12, Romans 12:1-2, Psalm 24:4*
- *Purity - Give our students an all-consuming hunger for righteousness. Grace to say no to sin and to flee sexual immorality. That they would see clearly the rewards of preserving the gift of sex for marriage. John 8:32, 1 Peter 1:5, Hebrews 13:4, 1 Corinthians 6:18, 1 John 4:4, James 1:12-14*
- *Passion - Grant this generation of teenagers an anointing of the power by the Holy Spirit, to be the greatest witnesses for Christ Jesus than we've ever known. - *Submission and Honor – We pray that this generation would submit to Christ and to those in authority over them. Give them grace to love, respect, and honor their parents, teachers, spiritual leaders, and governing officials. Ephesians 6:2-3; Hebrews 13:17; Mark 12:17*

Day 14 - Healing

- *Give people in authority godly counsel and God-fearing advisors. May they have wisdom to discern bad advice and chose what is good. Proverbs 24:6*
- *Father, help the families of those in authority. May they be honest and faithful to spouses and children. Malachi 2:15-16*
- *Help people in authority see the need to be connected to a local church. Help them become contributing members of the Body of Christ. Hebrews 10:25*
- *Help them avoid and resist perversion, sexual sin, and dishonesty. May they pursue purity and holiness. 1 Corinthians 6:9-20, Titus 2:12*
- *Help them be honest in financial, tax, and ethical matters. 1 Corinthians 6:10,*
- *1 Timothy 6:6-10*
- *Surround them with godly friendships. Psalms 1:1-3*
- *Help them be compassionate and generous toward others. Psalms 112:9, Luke 10:33-37*
- *Give them wisdom to deal with important issues. Help them redeem their time and know what should be a priority. Ephesians 5:15-17*
